Local Rules

1. LIFT, CLEAN & PLACE (LCP) When a player's ball lies in a part of the **player's OWN FAIRWAY**, the player may take free relief [ball in play once addressed] by placing the original ball in and play from this relief area:

Reference Point: Spot of the original ball;

Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference

Point: Within one club-length from the reference point;

Limits on Location of Relief Area: Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in the General Area.

Penalty for Playing from a Wrong Place under this Local Rule:**General Penalty.**

2. PENALTY AREAS In the absence of solid red or yellow penalty area boundary lines, all areas on each hole beyond the last cut of rough shall be deemed Lateral Penalty Areas.

3. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

Tire ruts, erosion, crevices and **all newly laid sod, damage or spot sanding on the greens** shall be deemed **Ground Under Repair (GUR).**

FOOTPRINTS in Bunkers and Waste Areas shall be deemed GUR allowing for relief from obstruction to stance or swing.

4. SPECIAL RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY

RELIEF In the absence of O.B. white stakes (adequate) , white line, fence or wall, any ball resting in an area virtually certain to be private property off the course shall be granted **GUR Mandatory Relief**. The player must drop the ball within 1-club length of the nearest point in the General Area on the course, no nearer to the hole than its original position, **without penalty**.
